Research Analysis

The floor substitute for SB 1057 creates the Marissa Murrow Act. The measure defines “event venue” as it relates to the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Control Act, and establishes an event venue license at an annual fee of \$500.00.

The measure requires event venues to allow patrons that become too intoxicated or otherwise impaired to leave their vehicle in the venue's parking lot overnight or for a reasonable amount of time. Provide security for events with one-hundred or more patrons in attendance and where alcohol will be available for consumption, and requires that the dedicated security personnel be a commissioned law enforcement officer or former officer that is present on the premises during all alcohol service times.

The measure also authorizes the holder of a caterer license to sell mixed beverages at licensed venues, and prohibits a caterer from selling or distributing alcoholic beverages on the premises of an event venue that does not hold an event venue license, as approved by the ABLE Commission.

CHANGES BETWEEN COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE AND FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

Modifies the previous definition for "event venue," establishes requirements for event venues, and rules for caterers and bartenders.
