Research Analysis

The committee substitute for SB 1119 increases teacher pay in the following manner:

\$3,000 increase for teachers with 0-4 years of experience \$4,000 increase for teachers with 5-9 years of experience \$5,000 increase for teachers with 10-14 years of experience \$6,000 increase for teachers with 15-25 years of experience

The measure clarifies that a teacher will receive the full salary increase regardless if their current pay is above the salary schedule. If a school district does not receive funding through the formula, the State Board of Education must allocate funds to cover the cost of the salary increases.

The measure clarifies that the raises are also applicable to teachers employed by CareerTech, the Department of Corrections, the Office of Juvenile Affairs, and the Department of Rehabilitation Services.

Lastly, the measure repeals the previous teacher minimum salary from statute:

Section 18-114.14 - Minimum Salary and Benefits
