SB 136 increases the sheriff's fee for serving or endeavoring to serve each writ, warrant, order, process, command, or notice or pursuing any fugitive from justice within and outside of the county from \$50 to \$150.

**Fiscal Analysis**

This measure increases the sheriff's fee from \$50 to \$150 for certain services in criminal cases. In its current form, SB136 has the potential to increase revenues without bearing any additional costs to the state budget, however the amount of cases that will occur is not predictable.
