Research Analysis

SB 1635 mandates that a licensee in the medical marijuana industry must furnish an affidavit for license renewal subsequent to presenting a certificate of compliance to the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority. This affidavit must confirm the ongoing adherence of the business to zoning regulations, pertinent municipal laws, and all relevant safety, electrical, fire, plumbing, waste, construction, and building codes. However, this requirement does not extend to licensees who have submitted a comprehensive application for a valid certificate of occupancy to either the State Fire Marshal or a political subdivision with a jurisdiction agreement on file with the State Fire Marshal before February 1, 2024. It is incumbent upon licensees to ensure compliance with state codes. Furthermore, the legislation delineates the terms "final harvest batch" and "final product."
