**Research Analysis**

The conference committee substitute to Senate Bill 1380 allows an administrator of an ICF/IID-16 to apply for a waiver from the mileage limitation by submitting an application to the State Department of Health. The application will be reviewed based on the facility's compliance history, residents' acuity ratios, and individual care plans. The State Commissioner of Health may establish rules to implement this waiver process. The measure also authorizes the State Commissioner of Health to waive provisions of the Long-Term Care Administrator Licensing Act, provided compliance with federal requirements and resident welfare are maintained. It permits Registered Nurses and Licensed Practical Nurses to prepare medications in nursing facilities within their licensure scope, as regulated by the Oklahoma Board of Nursing and the State Commissioner of Health.
