Research Analysis

The CCS to SB 1407 authorizes the Department of Public Safety to create and administer Oklahoma child abduction response teams (OCARTS) to mitigate child endangerment. The commissioner is authorized to employ an OCART coordinator to assist in administering OCARTS and create OCART committees. Each OCART committee is to develop a plan for mounting a coordinated response to a verified child abduction. The plan must include an outline of the procedure for verification of a child abduction, a notification of a child abduction, outreach to local law enforcement agencies, and member agency responsibilities in the event of a verified child abduction. Within 4 hours of receiving a report of verified child abduction, the law enforcement agency is to notify the Oklahoma Counter Terrorism Intelligence Center. Law enforcement agencies are hereby authorized to utilize the automated license plate readers in carrying out a coordinated response to a verified child abduction.
