Research Analysis

The engrossed version of SB 147 allows school boards to adopt a policy for stocking glucogen in order to treat diabetic students in an emergency. A district that stocks glucogen must receive parental permission to administer glucogen to a student experiencing an emergency. The parent must also sign a waiver of liability. The parental permission and liability waiver must be renewed annually.
