SB 1569 modifies the Oklahoma Carbon Sequestration Enhancement Act so that Oklahoma Conservation Commission no longer has jurisdiction over the Class VI underground injection wells used for storing carbon dioxide related to oil and gas activity.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 1569 clarifies that the Conservation Commission may administer a terrestrial and agriculture carbon sequestration certification program; this program would no longer oversee carbon sequestration through injection of carbon dioxide underground. As written, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
