Research Analysis

The Engrossed version of SB 16 requires the State Board of Education to establish a two-year pilot program in which school districts are granted funding to provide childcare to district employees. The criteria for awarding the grants must be based on the availability of child care in the district and the need among district employees, among other things. The grants must go to a representative sample of districts across the state.

The grants may be used to:

- Create an on-site licensed child care facility;
- Contract with a licensed child care facility; or
- Provide district employees with stipends for child care.
