The amendment to the floor amendment for SB1635 modifies the application date from November 1, 2023 to November 1, 2024.

Previous summary:

SB1635 allows for existing medical marijuana businesses without a valid certificate of occupancy to have their licenses revoked unless they submitted a completed application before November 1, 2023, and it is currently under review.

Businesses are responsible for complying with state fire, building, and electrical codes, and they could be liable for damages resulting from non-compliance.
