**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to SB1635 allows medical marijuana growers who have provided the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority a certificate of compliance from the relevant political subdivision or the State Fire Marshal to receive a license renewal without obtaining additional compliance certificates. The licensee is only required to submit an affidavit confirming ongoing compliance.

However, changes in use or occupancy require additional inspection or permits, and a new certificate of compliance and affidavit must be provided. Municipalities or the State Fire Marshal may conduct inspections to ensure compliance.

Operations will be suspended if a violation is found until compliance is restored. Premises licensed before the act's effective date will be allowed licensure for needing a compliance certificate after July 1, 2025, if they have a certificate from a political subdivision on file with the State Fire Marshal.
