## **Research Analysis**

Engrossed Senate Bill 1638 requires that reports submitted to law enforcement regarding a child absconding or missing from foster placement must include a photo of the missing child, a detailed description of their physical features, and information about potential endangerment. The measure requires the Department of Human Services to maintain regular communication with law enforcement and the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children to provide for the safe recovery of a missing or abducted child or youth.
