**Research Analysis**

Engrossed Senate Bill 1751 requires that guardians of incapacitated adults must complete training relevant to the specific condition of the individual under their care. Courts are authorized to enforce this requirement by compelling individuals seeking guardianship to undergo the prescribed training.

**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1751 provides training requirements, and a list of approved training programs, to be maintained by the Oklahoma Department of Human Services (OKDHS) relating to guardianship. After communication with OKDHS, suitable training programs currently exist such that only minimal implementation costs may be required.
