**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for SB 1768 allows a school district to utilize up to 10 scheduled or unscheduled virtual days throughout the year. Valid use of a virtual day is limited to inclement weather, unavailability of teachers due to illness, building maintenance issues, or other reasons approved by the State Board of Education.

Any time a virtual day is used, the district must notify the SDE within 72 hours. The SDE then has one calendar week to determine whether the virtual day was used properly. If not, the school is required to implement a make-up day.

The measure also authorizes the SDE to audit the virtual day, ensuring a majority of students complied with the district's policy for using virtual days.
