Fiscal Analysis

This measure establishes a \$500 annual event venue license to be overseen by the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission. According to officials with ABLE, this fee is a straight pass through to the State General Revenue (GR) Fund. ABLE anticipates as many as 3,000 or more potential annual licensees, thereby generating at least \$1,500,000 in new revenues for the State GR Fund. The agency also anticipates that they will need to update agency software to create this new license in their system, and expects to incur administrative costs to regulate and prepare for this influx of new licensees, but was not able to provide an estimate of these costs. If the agency is unable to absorb these costs, future appropriations may be sought to implement the provisions of SB1818.
