# **Research Analysis**

The floor substitute to SB 1860 requires the Governor and any officer serving as acting Governor to electronically notify the next officer in the line of succession if they plan to leave the state. The electronic notification must be sent at least 24 hours in advance and include the departure and return dates and times.

### CHANGES IN FLOOR SUB VERSION FROM COMMITTEE SUB:

The floor substitute to SB 1860 requires the notification be sent at least 24 hours prior to leaving the state and clarifies that the notification requirement only applies to officers listed in the line of succession when serving as acting Governor.

# **Fiscal Analysis**

The floor substitute to SB 1860 requires the Governor and every office holder listed in the line of succession for the Office of the Governor to notify his or her successor of any absence from the state at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance.
