**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 187 relates to adoption, and increases the allowable amount of certain expenses payable by any person, attorney, or licensed child-placing agency to birth mothers from \$1,000.00 to \$3,500.00. The measure does not mandate any action or expenditure by a state agency. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
