Research Analysis

The committee substitute for SB 32x requires that from the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority:

- \$30,000,000.00 be used to provide grant funding to providers for the one-time connection to the state-designated entity for health information exchange.
- \$47,767,458.00 be used to increase reimbursement to long-term care facilities by \$35.00 per day and reimbursement to intermediate care facilities for individuals with intellectual disabilities (ICF/IID) by \$17.00 per day.
- \$200,000,000.00 shall be used for onetime funding to critical access hospitals and hospitals participating in the Supplemental Hospital Offset Payment Program.

The measure requires that the Authority submit, to the Senate Appropriations Committee Chair and the House of Representatives Appropriations and Budget Committee Chair, a plan for the disbursement of the funds listed in the measure by no later than July 31st, 2023.

The measure also directs the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to transfer monies between the Oklahoma Health Care Authority federal and revolving funds in amounts requested by the Authority.
