Research Analysis

The engrossed version of SB 365 requires state colleges and universities to provide a student with course credit if they have achieved a certain score – set by the College Board – on the CLEP exam. The measure prohibits state colleges and universities from requiring a higher CLEP score than the one set by the College Board, except when a college or university president provides evidence that a higher score is necessary to prove that a student is prepared to be successful.
