Research Analysis

SB 377 adds being excused from jury duty for not being a United States citizen to the list of reasons to cancel a voter's registration. The measure also requires the court clerk in each county to provide the list of all persons adjudged incapacitated to the secretary of the county election board. The court clerk must also prepare a list of all persons excused from jury duty for not being US citizens each month and provide the list to the secretary of the county election board. The secretary must cancel the registration of each registered person on the list and then report any person or persons to the district attorney and the county's United State attorney.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 377 adds that being excused from jury duty to not being a citizen of the United States as a valid reason for the cancelation of voter registration and requires the court clerk in each county to provide a monthly list of all persons excused from jury duty for this reason. Per the State Election Board (SEB), the addition from this measure would result in a minimal fiscal impact to the agency.
