Research Analysis

The committee substitute for SB 38x appropriates \$5 million from the Statewide Recovery Fund to the State Regents for Higher Education for the purpose of implementing teacher acceleration programs. The State Regents are authorized to enter into MOUs with other agencies for the auditing, evaluation, and oversight of the programs. The Regents may retain no more than 2 percent of the funds to administer the program. The Regents must submit quarterly budgeting reports to the chairs of the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding.

Lastly, the Regents are required to prove that any nonprofits associated with the project can provide direct services to Oklahomans, are in good standing with the state, and are in compliance with state and federal tax laws.
