Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to SB 437 requires that within 30 days of the effective date on the measure, the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority (OMMA) to select, through a competitive bidding process, a vendor that will produce and provide a seed-to-sale inventory tracking system for medical marijuana business licensees.

The measure requires that OMMA be responsible for all costs associated with the seed-to-sale tracking system, outlines the specific features the system should include, and <u>repeals Title 63</u>, <u>Section 427.13</u> relating to Purchasing - Oversight and Auditing - Inventory Tracking
