## **Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB 440 directs the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority to promulgate rules to limit the tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) potency of medical marijuana and medical marijuana products sold in medical marijuana dispensaries.

The measure requires that THC content not exceed 1,000 mg of delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol per package for edible medical marijuana products, 5 mg of delta-8 tetrahydrocannabinol or any other tetrahydrocannabinol isomer or analogue that occurs naturally in cannabis per package for edible medical marijuana products, or an action level of 1.0 parts per million of any tetrahydrocannabinol isomer, tetrahydrocannabinol analogue, or any other cannabinoid that does not occur naturally in cannabis per package for edible medical marijuana products.

The measure prohibits licensed dispensaries from selling edible medical marijuana product that exceed the THC per package.

Furthermore, the measure authorizes then Executive Director to impose further limits on THC per serving in edible medical marijuana products for patients under the age of 18.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

SB 440 directs the Executive Director of Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority to promulgate rules regarding tetrahydrocannabinol potency of medical marijuana products sold in dispensaries and licensed facilities may sell medical marijuana products that exceed the THC per package. The measure allows the Executive Director may impose further limits on THC per serving in edibles. No fiscal impact is anticipated.
