## **Research Analysis**

SB 509 creates the Oklahoma Civil Rights Trail Grant Program to provide financial assistance for the preservation of the Oklahoma City Rights Trail. The Board of Directors of the Oklahoma Historical Society is authorized to develop rules and procedures for distributing the grants. The measure also creates the Oklahoma Civil Rights Trail Revolving Fund.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

This measure creates the Oklahoma Civil Rights Trail Grant Program, and creates a revolving fund for the program. This measure does not make an appropriation into the fund. Additionally, it is a grant program for which rules shall be promulgated for by the Oklahoma Historical Society (OHS) after the passage of the measure. Given that there is no direct appropriation, and that it is a new program with no rules yet, there is no known fiscal impact on the measure. OHS is considering if such a program might require one additional staff person to manage and at what salary range.
