**Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB608 creates an administrative process for a licensee to file a written protest to the Oklahoma Tax Commission within sixty days of receiving a notice of refusal by the OTC to issue, extend, or reinstate any license or permit. If the licensee requires an administrative hearing on the issue in their protest request, the OTC must give the applicant at least 10 days' notice for the hearing.
