Research Analysis

The second floor amendment to SB 645 inserts a new subsection D to section 1, that allows the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority to promulgate the rules necessary for pre-packaged products to be returned to the licensed medical dispensary when found defective or hazardous to the health of the patient, and for the return of defective or hazardous products between licensed entities.

SB 645, as amended, provides that any medical marijuana flower, trim, shake, kief, medical marijuana product, or other flower-based product not defined as a concentrate, shall be sold by licensed medical marijuana processors and licensed medical marijuana commercial growers to licensed medical marijuana dispensaries only in pre-packaged form in package sizes weighing not less than half of a gram and not more than 3 ounces. The measure allows for nonopaque materials to be used when packaging medical marijuana flowers, and allows the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority to promulgate rules relating to the return of defective or hazardous products between licensed entities.
