Research Analysis

The PCS1 to SB 688 requires all driver licenses issued to persons 65 and older to be issued for an eight year period. The measure directs Service Oklahoma to include, either on the front or back of the driver license or the identification card, a numeric designation indicating a veteran's 100% disability rating granted to the veteran by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or any other applicable disability rating. The spouse of a 100% disabled veteran or an unremarried surviving spouse of a deceased, 100% disabled veteran shall be entitled to receive a driver license or identification card indicating his or her status as an eligible current spouse or an eligible unremarried surviving spouse entitled to the sales tax exemption. Service Oklahoma and the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs are to implement a technology-based information exchange process to allow motor agents to validate an applicant's claim of veteran status.
