Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to engrossed SB 7 authorizes a municipality or public trust to lease a public lake or public land abutting a lake without abandoning or declaring those public lands as surplus property. The leased land must be used for amusement, parks, or recreation. A municipality or public trust can enter into contracts with any person, entity, or governmental entity to manage the leased land. The measure also allows a municipality to own, construct, and operate a marina.

Fiscal Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to SB 7 allows a municipality or public trust to lease a public lake or public land abutting a lake for various purposes without abandoning or declaring these public lands as surplus property.
