**Research Analysis**

The floor substitute to SB 704 expands The Oklahoma State University Medical Authority to eight members by adding a position for a member of the Board of Regents for the Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical Colleges to be selected Chair of the Board of Regents.

The measure requires the Authority to provide funding to other entities for purposes related to public health, teaching, research, and the purposes of the Oklahoma State University Medical Authority Act.

The measure also repeals [63 O.S. § 3287](#) which establishes the Oklahoma State University Medical Authority Marketing Revolving Fund.

**CHANGES BETWEEN COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE AND FLOOR SUBSTITUTE**

- Removes the authorization for The Authority to hold meetings by videoconference.
- Removes the repealer for [63 O.S. § 3291](#) which pertains to then Contingency Review Board - Review of Proposed Lease and Operations of Hospitals – Supreme Court Review.
