**Research Analysis**

SB 721 strikes language requiring firearms instructors to train with a specific type of firearm in order to qualify as an instructor for that firearm. The measure removes a requirement that a person honorably discharged from active military duty be within 20 years of such discharge before being exempt from firearm training necessary to obtain a carry concealed license.
