Fiscal Analysis

The CCR to SB 758 outlines the credentialing process for medical marijuana employees and specifies duties of the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority (OMMA) when reviewing applications.

According to OMMA, the measure aligns the employee credential application with standards applied to all other agency applications. OMMA may reject applications for certain errors, which allows the applicant to correct those issues within thirty (30) days at no additional cost, rather than denying the application and requiring the applicant to pay the fee again. Although the number of applications requiring denial versus rejection is unknown, OMMA anticipates the impact to be minimal. Any variance in application fees received by the agency will be absorbed within existing resources, thus having no direct fiscal impact on the state budget.
