SB 762 designates an intersection in Payne County as The Honorable Secretary Gary M. Ridley Memorial Interchange.

**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 762 designates "The Honorable Secretary Gary M. Ridley Memorial Interchange" in Payne County. Title 69 O.S. § 1600 provides that the costs associated with signage related to the naming of highways and bridges is to be paid by the group sponsoring or requesting the sign, except in instances of naming a highway or bridge to honor members of the United States Armed Forces, Oklahoma Highway Patrol, peace officers, and first responders who were killed in the performance of their duties.

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) currently estimates a cost of \$1,300 per location that meets these qualifications, with one sign needed at each end of the designated highway or bridge.
