**Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB 804 eliminates the requirement for licensed electrolysis practitioners to register their license with the county clerk. The measure also repeals [59 O.S. Section 510](#), which requires firms, associations, or corporations practicing medicine to report the names and addresses of all physicians connected to such entities to the county clerk.
