**Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB 805 exonerates a bond when the defendant's bondsman or insurer requests that the prosecuting attorney file felony bond jumping charges against the defendant if they fail to surrender within 30 days from failing to appear in court and the prosecuting attorney has not filed such charges within 30 business days of the request.

**Fiscal Analysis**

This measure relates to the forfeiture procedure of bonds, allowing a bond to be exonerated by the bondsman or insurer under certain conditions following a written request of the prosecuting attorney.
