**Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB 93 requires students to complete and submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) in order to graduate from a public high school. The measure provides opportunities to opt out of the requirements and also directs the State Department of Education to publish materials explaining the requirement as well as an opt-out form to be used by school districts.
