Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for SB 931 expands the practice of pharmacy to include ordering, performing, and interpreting tests authorized by the Food and Drug Administration and waived under the federal Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments of 1988 as well as the initiation of drug therapy for minor, nonchronic health conditions. The measure expands the practice to include the dispensing of self-administered hormonal contraceptives.

The measure also prohibits a pharmacist from testing or screening for streptococcus and initiating drug therapy for streptococcus to individuals under the 6 years old.
