**Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB 941 modifies hunting and fishing license fees for residents and nonresidents. The measure requires the Wildlife Commission to submit a report to the legislature every five years with proposed licensing fees based on the latest Consumer Price Index. The age at which residents and non residents are exempt from having a fishing or hunting license is increased from 16 to 18. Lastly, the measure clarifies that a resident in possession of a lifetime hunting license, or combination hunting/fishing license, is exempt from the annual black bear license requirements.
