**Research Analysis**

Floor amendment 1 to SB97 clarifies that a mediator's report to the court can be disclosed in a mediation proceeding.

As amended, SB97 outlines information pertaining to a mediation proceeding that is prohibited from disclosure. Other than a mediator's report to the court, the mediation scheduling, attendance, participation, or discussion of any proposed settlement agreement, items agreed upon or disputed, or the intent of the parties must remain confidential.
