**Bill Analysis**

HB 1035 provides for the excused absence of a student for mental health counseling and occupational therapy if, before the absence, the parent, guardian, or other person with custody of the child submits a written request for the excused absence. It directs the school district to excuse the absence upon receipt of documentation from the mental health or occupational therapy provider.
