## **Bill Analysis**

HB 1350 directs the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority to require all persons or entities seeking licensure as a medical marijuana commercial grower, medical marijuana processor, medical marijuana dispensary, or medical marijuana transporter to first apply for a temporary medical marijuana business license beginning November 1, 2023. The temporary license shall not authorize the holder to conduct any sales of medical marijuana or marijuana products, the growing or processing of marijuana, or the transportation of any medical marijuana or marijuana products. The license shall be valid for 180 days and may be extended by 90 days if certain conditions are met. The measure establishes a nonrefundable fee of \$1,000.00 for the initial issuance of the license as well as for each 90-day extension. Entities applying for the license are required to submit certain documents outlined in the measure. An annual license shall not be issued until the Authority determines that all necessary inspections and reviews have been completed.
