Bill Analysis

HB 1734 directs the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority to require owners and employees of medical marijuana facilities to submit their fingerprints to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI) to conduct a criminal background check. The measure authorizes the Authority to require the submission of such fingerprints as part of the application or renewal process for a license. Fingerprint cards and any required fees shall be sent to the OSBI central repository.
