Bill Analysis

HB 2305 establishes the Oklahoma PFAS Act. The measure authorizes the Department of Environmental Quality to promulgate rules relating to the disposal of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS). The Department shall review applications for receiving, storing, treating, or disposing of such waste. The measure provides liability protection for treatment costs in the case of a release to eight categories of passive receivers of PFAS waste. The measure provides that aqueous film-forming foam containing intentionally added PFAS (AFFF) from another state shall maintain the same classification or characterization it would receive in the state of origin. The measure bans the disposal of such waste if the state of origin bans the disposal of such waste.
