**Bill Analysis**

SB 1040 provides that if a person provided an electronic mail address to apply for the issuance or renewal of an Oklahoma driver license, Service Oklahoma shall request by electronic means whether the person wishes to register to vote or to change his or her address for voting purposes. Any person who declines to register must opt out of registration using electronic means. No voter registration services shall be offered to any person who provides documentation indicating they are not a citizen of the United States. The measure eliminates obsolete language authorizing the Secretary of the State Election Board to develop a system to electronically transmit voter registration applications from licensed operators to the State Election Board or county election boards.
