**Bill Analysis**

SB 1057 creates the Marissa Murrow Act. The measure defines “event venue” as it relates to the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Control Act as a location, property, space, premises, grounds, building or buildings, or other site that offers to the general public for rent, lease, reservation, or other contractual use, for the hosting of a function, occasion, or event, special, private, or public, of a temporary nature as a primary source of income. The measure authorizes the holder of a caterer license to sell mixed beverages at licensed venues. A caterer shall not sell or distribute alcoholic beverages on the premises of an event venue unless the event venue holds an event venue license, as approved by the ABLE Commission.
