Bill Analysis

SB 1057 modifies the license revocation period of persons convicted of driving under the influence. The measure provides that the minimum period shall be 1 year instead of 180 days after the first conviction, 3 years instead of 1 year after the second conviction, and 5 years instead of 2 years after the third conviction. The length of the Impaired Driver Accountability Program a person must complete in order to retain his or her license is also increased to match the respective revocation periods.
