Bill Analysis

SB 1065 provides that a person required to use an ignition interlock device who proceeds to use a vehicle without such a device shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to imprisonment lasting no less than 30 days and no longer than 6 months and/or a fine of \$500.00. Such punishment may be waived by the court only for a person who enrolls in and completes the Impaired Driver Accountability Program (IDAP).
