Bill Analysis

SB 1067 authorizes eligible employers to investigate all current employees or persons who were employed by the state for illegal conduct. The eligible employer shall have the responsibility to determine a reasonable basis for investigation related to alleged illegal or inappropriate conduct. Such an investigation shall follow fair procedure and shall not violate an employee's reasonable expectation of privacy. The eligible employer shall report illegal conduct found during the investigation to proper authorities. Any person convicted as a result of such an investigation may be deprived of his or her pension.
