Bill Analysis

SB 1086 requires any permanency plan for a child under the age of 12 months to include a goal that the infant be placed in a prospective permanent placement within 1 year after the child has been adjudicated to be a deprived child. Additionally, the measure provides that if a child was abandoned as an infant at 12 months or younger, the timely manner provided for in the permanency plan shall mean 3 months after the court determined the child was deprived or abandoned.
