**Bill Analysis**

SB 1098 prohibits any political subdivision from allowing or permitting a public display of lewd acts or obscene material in a public place. Such places shall include parades, shows, concerts, plays, or any other activity where a minor could witness such lewd acts or obscene material. No individual shall be allowed to show lewd acts or obscene material in a public place where any other individual could witness such lewd acts or obscene material. Persons found to have violated this prohibition shall be guilty of a felony. Any person may have a cause of action against such individual who intentionally commits such acts in any manner in which a minor was exposed to the lewd act or obscene material, or an individual was unwillingly exposed to the lewd act or obscene material.
