Bill Analysis

SB 1119 provides an increase to the minimum teacher salary schedule. The increases are as follows:

- 1) \$3,000.00 for years 0-4
- 2) \$4,000.00 for years 5-9
- 3) \$5,000.00 for years 10-14
- 4) \$6,000.00 for years 15-25+

The salary schedule applies to any certified person employed on a full-time basis to serve as a teacher, principal, supervisor, administrator, counselor, librarian, or certified or registered nurse by a school district. The increase shall also apply to personnel who were paid above the salary schedule during the prior school year. If a school district does not receive Foundation Aid or Salary Incentive Aid, the State Board of Education will allocate funds to cover the cost of the salary increases. The increase shall also apply to career and technology school district, Department of Corrections, Office of Juvenile Affairs, and Department of Rehabilitation Services educators.
